
HAELE-10: Discussion Seeking the future for Altered Earth in Asia

We are thinking of producing an Asian edition of *Altered Earth: Getting the Anthropocene Right*, edited by Julia Adeney Thomas, tentatively titled *Altered Earth in Asia*.
